Resolution from BCRP Executive Committee requesting all Beaufort County Federal and State Elected Officials oppose any attempt by the Democrat Party to “Pack the U.S. Supreme Court”

WHEREAS, Democrats have introduced legislation that would add 4 more seats to the Supreme Court, increasing the total number of judges to 13; and

WHEREAS, if passed, this would allow President Joseph Biden to immediately name 4 new judges, obviously Democratic thereby giving the Democrats a 7 to 6 majority; and

WHEREAS, this is simply another in a long line of Democrat attempts to accomplish through the courts what they cannot accomplish at the ballot box through making and changing laws through liberal court rulings rather than through the constitutional process.
